<p>C. B.: "It took me a while to figure out a problem with the ID. To me, the ID implies that it should (or at least, could) be a number. For many experiments, anonymously is key. The issue is is that you evaluate:</p> <pre>sprintf('%s=indDat;',indDat.id)</pre> <p>If indDat is a number, this wouldn't be valid. E.g.:</p> <p>1=indDat % not valid Brecht... 1 == 1 and always will be!!!</p> <p>I'd suggest changing this so that it saves it in a variable called ParticipantData and then saves it to a file with save([indDat.id, 'mat'], 'indDat'). I guess it's not a crucial point at the moment, as long as you make that point in the manual or do an error check with a meaningful message."</p>
