<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Ask to create a new publication and add an author</li><li>2. Type something into author search</li><li>3. Select an author in results list</li><li>4. Click the "No" button -- observe that the text fields are cleared (correctly)</li><li>5. Click the "Yes" button</li></ol> <p>Now the text fields are still empty, and are also un-editable, but the author you selected in the search results earlier is still selected. (Does that mean the author will be used when I submit the form, or not?)</p> <p>Really at step 4 the selection also needs to be cleared from the author search results. Or else at step 5 the text fields should be re-filled from the selection, but I think the former is probably more sensible.</p>
