The initial Explore page feature request (#564) called for exploration in four directions: **Active**, **Relevant to me**, **Complete or respected**, and through **search/tag**.

The current page handles Active and search/tag (at least somewhat). Relevance is partly handled through the My Page box showing what my colleagues are working on, though we could use (separately) a relevance browser for wider projects and non-registered users.

That leaves Complete or respected. There is a partly-implemented Mature Projects metric for this, but it isn't good enough.

- After eliminating projects that are "too immature" or have no description or managers, it selects at random N projects that have no managers in common.
